The safety of your children is paramount in all public schools.


At Tamworth South we have been reassessing school security and are working with the school safety and security directorate to install security cameras at our Woodward Avenue gateway so people can be identified prior to entry.

From Monday all gates, Petra Avenue, Kent Street and the carpark gate will be locked at 9:30am and then unlocked at 2:45pm. Between these hours all visitors are required to report to the office on arrival and must enter via the Woodward Avenue gateway. I realise this may cause some angst if you forget about the new arrangements for which I apologise in advance. As discussed at our recent P&C meeting the security of our school is paramount and non-negotiable.

Recipe

2 tablespoons of butter	2 tablespoons of sugar
3 tablespoons of SR flour	1 egg
1 teaspoon vanilla essence	

Method

Mix butter and sugar together until it is creamy.
Add the self-raising flour slowly to the mix.
Then add the egg and mix together.
Finally add 1 teaspoon of vanilla essence and mix well.

We cooked them in an electric pop cake machine and an electric shape maker.


You can easily put the mixture into a cupcake tray and bake them in the oven. Moderate heat should be used.
